

## Main and strategic recommendations:

- Ensure a common definition of PSE and its modalities as the form of Technical Cooperation that mobilizes international institutional partnerships between peer administrations and experts from/through public institutions.
- Integrate clear reference to PSE into the NDICI programming exercise and increase use of PSE through the Team Europe coordination efforts.
- Improve coordination, synergies and learning exchange between EU
  and its MS to enhance full awareness of PSEs benefit.
- Incentivize the involvement of public experts in international assignments.
- Increase the promotion of joint implementation around sharing of knowledge and experience by European public administration.
