adopting a multiannual indicative programme for Sri Lanka for the period 2021-2027

THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) 2021/947 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 9 June 2021 establishing the Neighbourhood, Development and International Cooperation Instrument – Global Europe amending and repealing Decision No 466/2014/EU and repealing Regulation (EU) 2017/1601 and Council Regulation (EC, Euratom) No 480/2009¹, and in particular Article 16 thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) Article 14(1) of Regulation (EU) 2021/947 provides that the implementation of the Neighbourhood, Development and International Cooperation Instrument – Global Europe is to be carried out for geographic programmes through multiannual country and multi-country indicative programmes.
- (2) In accordance with Article 9(4), first sub-paragraph of Council Decision (EU) 427/2010², this multiannual indicative programme has been prepared jointly by the European External Action Service (EEAS) and the relevant Commission services under the guidance of the Commissioner responsible for International Partnerships, and submitted jointly with the High Representative of the Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy/Vice-President of the Commission to the College of Commissioners for adoption by the Commission. The multiannual indicative programme for Sri Lanka for the period 2021-2027 should be adopted by the Commission on behalf of the European Union.
- (3) The measures provided for in this Decision are in accordance with the opinion of the Neighbourhood, Development and International Cooperation Instrument – Global Europe Committee,
