

## **Introduction to EU External Action 2024 Data Overview**

Welcome to the EU External Action 2024 Data Overview Excel file. This document offers a comprehensive overview of the data presented in the 2024 Annual Report on the implementation of the European Union's external action instruments in 2023. The data encompasses various aspects of the EU's activities and achievements, categorised according to the respective results framework.

This file exclusively covers data from interventions funded under the Multi-Annual Financial Framework (MFF) for the period 2014-2020. The data presented here has remained unchanged since the previous report, with data collection finalized in May 2023. In 2024, the timing of the annual Results Reporting Exercise was adjusted to align with the corporate reporting timeline. Consequently, the exercise no longer took place in the spring, as it traditionally had, but in the fall. This change was implemented to ensure the availability of corporate results early in the following year, in line with the corporate reporting schedule. The results gathered in the fall of 2024 will be published in the next Annual Report, resulting in a shorter lag between the generation of results and their reporting compared to previous years.

The data is organised to reflect contributions from different EU Delegations, with data resulting from interventions managed by Headquarter aggregated under the category "Multiple" or "Other".

This file should constitute a valuable resource to analyse the EU's activities and impact during the above-mentioned specified period. For a full picture, please read chapter 6 "Results annexes" of the 2024 Annual Report's Staff Working Document.
