CLIMATE AND ENERGY


Support South Africa in the decarbonisation of its economy by increasing renewable energy generation, developing sustainable green hydrogen and critical raw materials value chains, upgrading transport and logistic networks, greening service delivery in municipalities, transferring expertise to government institutions, and providing technical and vocational training.

INFRASTRUCTURE

Support the implementation of the government's infrastructure programme and contribute to addressing the constraints to infrastructure development. Efforts are directed towards upgrading roads, railways, and ports to enhance connectivity, facilitate trade, and foster economic growth.

GOOD GOVERNANCE

Improve public services in rural areas, strengthen local authorities, and ensure equitable access to essential services, thereby contributing to more effective and accountable governance.



EDUCATION

Help establish a skilled workforce by improving:

- TVET (Technical and Vocational Education and Training) and Science Technology and Innovation to modernise and reform higher education institutions, develop new curricula and improve governance
- Investment climate, innovative finance and support to small and mediumsized enterprises in accessing finance

HEALTH

Local vaccine manufacturing: support South Africa's ambition in becoming a vaccine manufacturing hub.

SOCIAL SECTORS, WOMEN AND YOUTH

- To create economic and social opportunities to empower young businesses and aspiring entrepreneurs
- To support the fight against genderbased violence and femicide
