Biotechnology

- Reinforcing the National Regulatory Agency's ability to monitor the safety and usefulness of biotechnological products
- Working at the regional level to strengthen regulatory systems and policies
- Strengthening cooperation across the Caribbean and Latin America in biotechnology
- Reinforcing cooperation at the scientific and industry level on issues like public procurement competences and infectious diseases
- Increasing the production of biotechnological products like vaccines to supply both the national public health needs and the export market

Heritage & Culture

Together, Cuba and the EU will rehabilitate the World Heritage Site in **Havana** – the **Convento de Santa Clara**, which will host the new **Santa Clara College**.



Renewable Energies

- Assisting the development of sustainable energy and climate policies at national and local levels
- Supporting major investments in renewable energy and designing financial solutions to support the investment of EU companies in the sector
- Creating a loan and micro-credit facility for new sustainable energy businesses and training them in innovation
- Preparing feasibility studies for wind and biomass projects
- Working with the Ministry of Energy and Mines, building out its capacity and increasing fundraising for the energy transition
- Creating a network of 10 Cuban and one EU university to strengthen research in renewable energy and energy efficiency
- Unlocking investment opportunities in the sector (EUROCLIMA)
- Promoting local energy efficiency and renewable energy, while supporting them materially for sustainable development and climate change adaptation

Fight against Gender Violence, Drugs, Money Laundering, and Vulnerable Groups Discrimination*

- Supporting Gender Action Plan III to eliminate gender-based violence and improve sexual and reproductive rights
- Supporting the implementation of the legal framework promoting gender rights
- Supporting the creation of a National Observatory against Drugs to increase cooperation on the issue with Europe
