Data Collection Methodology and Impact

1. DATA COLLECTION

A new data collection cycle is initiated: Focal Points voluntarily collect data internally and report it.

2. DATA ENTRY AND CHECK

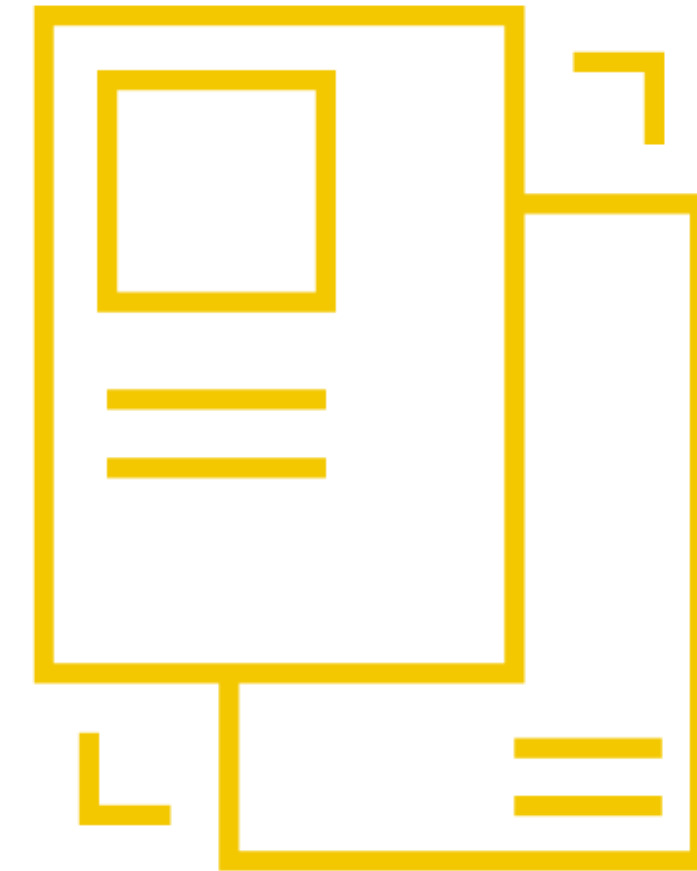
Focal Points report initiatives which are checked for consistency and accuracy.

3. DATA VISUALS AND ANALYSIS

The data is extracted, organised, and made available online to all JVAP Partners.

4. DATA-DRIVEN MIGRATION POLICY

- The data substantiates reports analysing the JVAP Follow-up progress
- Enables decision makers to develop fact-based migration policies and share good practices
- Feeds data and information to the Khartoum Process and Rabat Process Thematic Meetings, Trainings and Political Meetings
- Ensures the transparency of the JVAP follow-up process, thus promoting trust building across the regions.

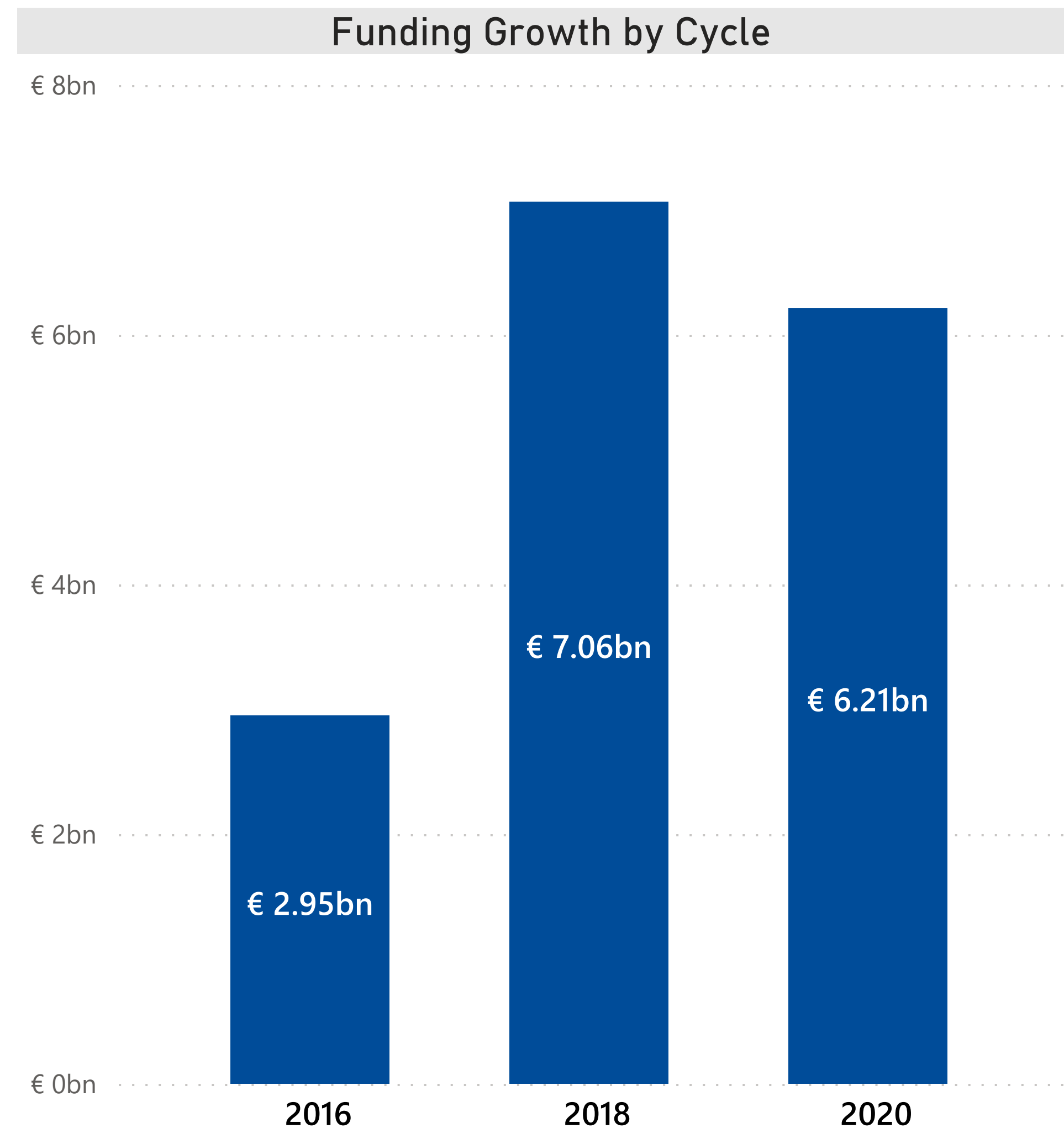
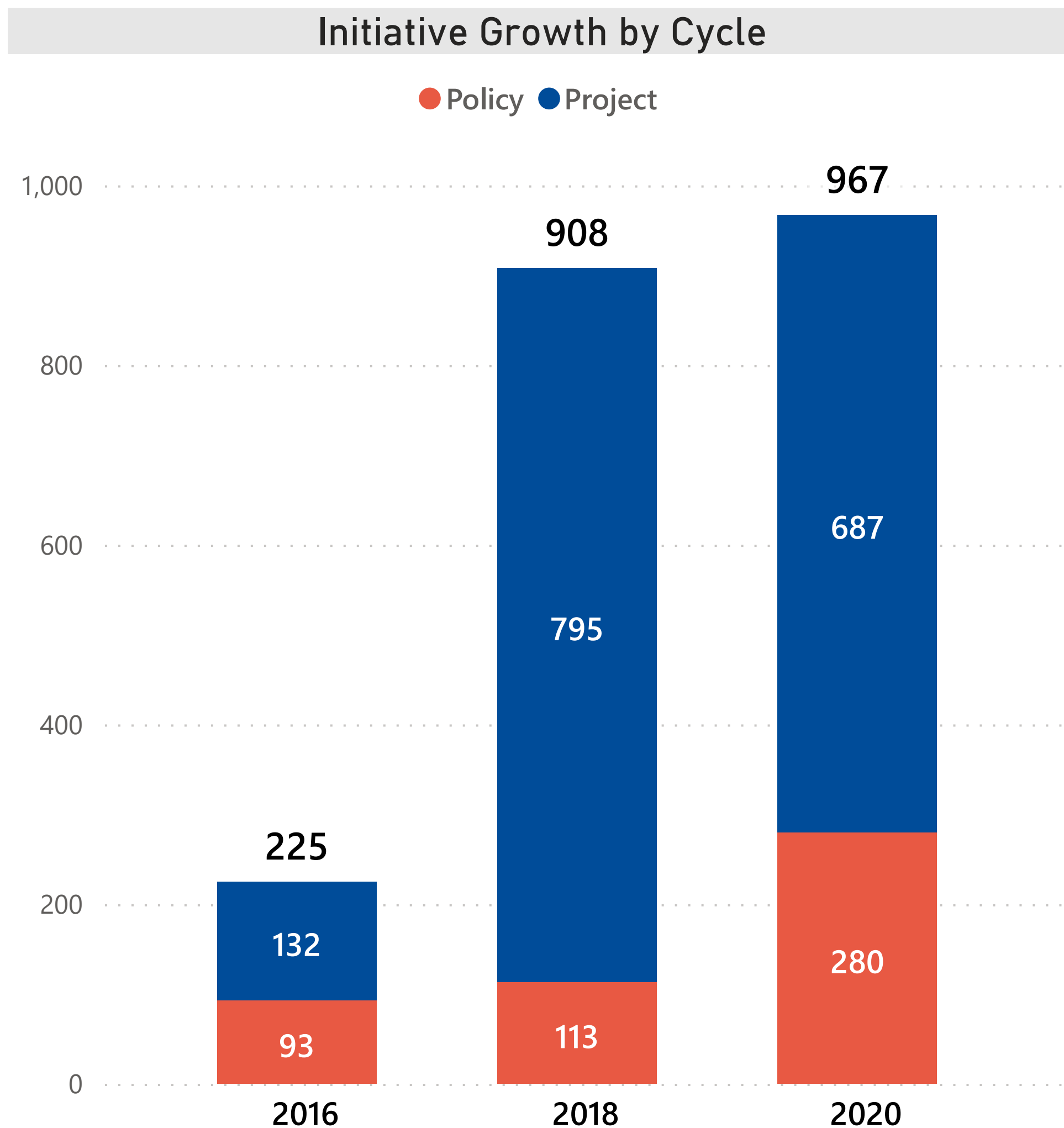

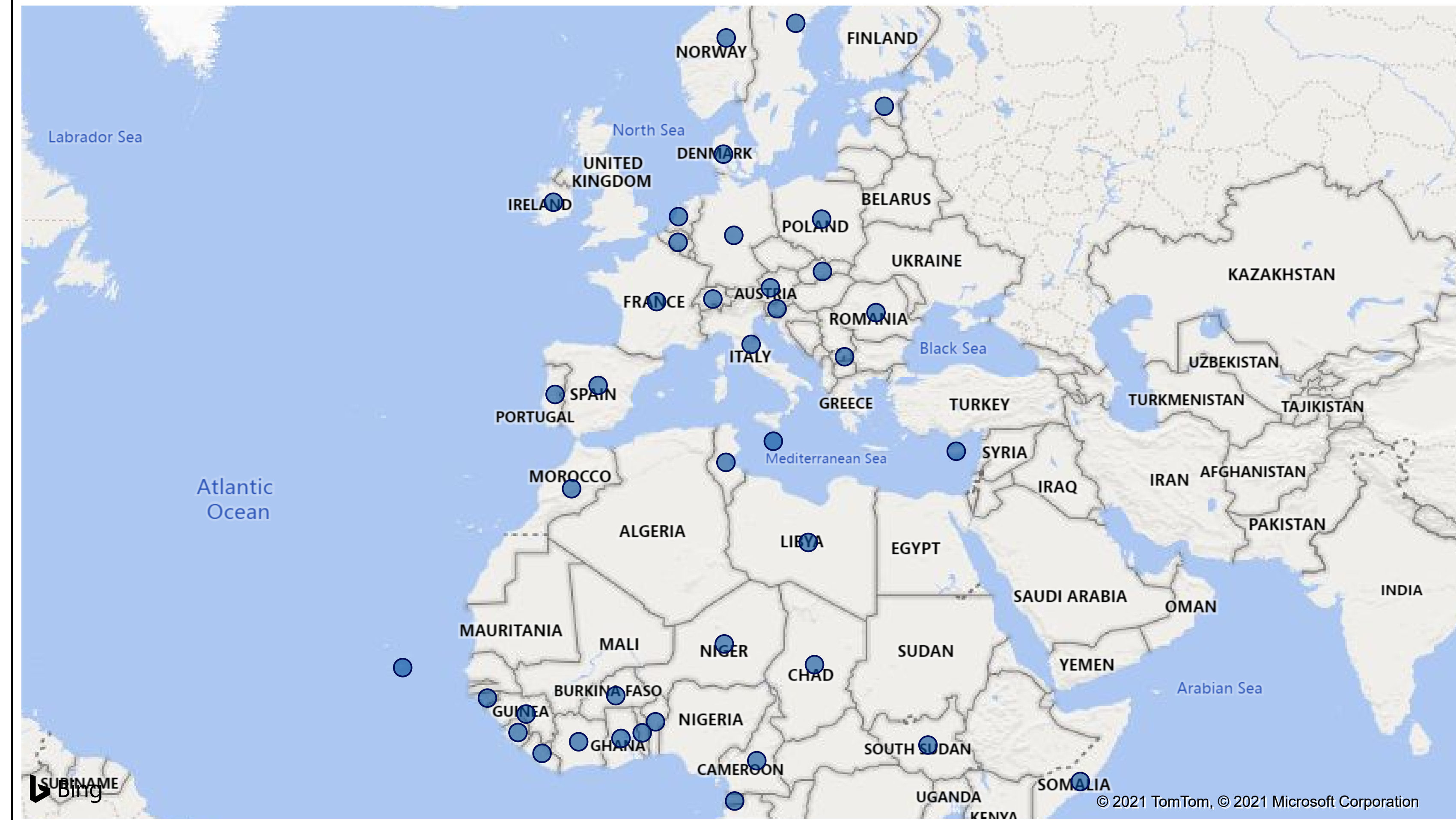

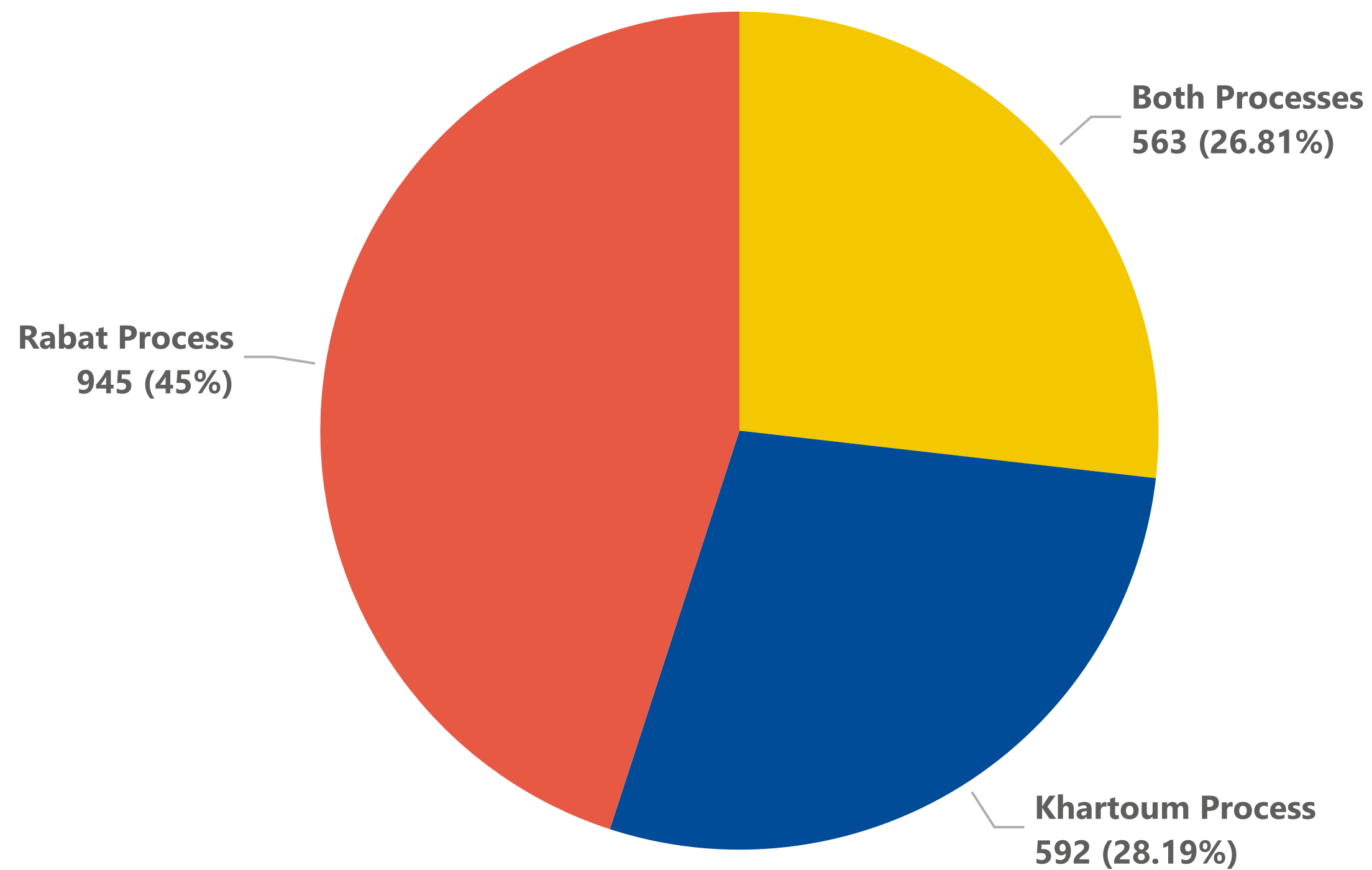

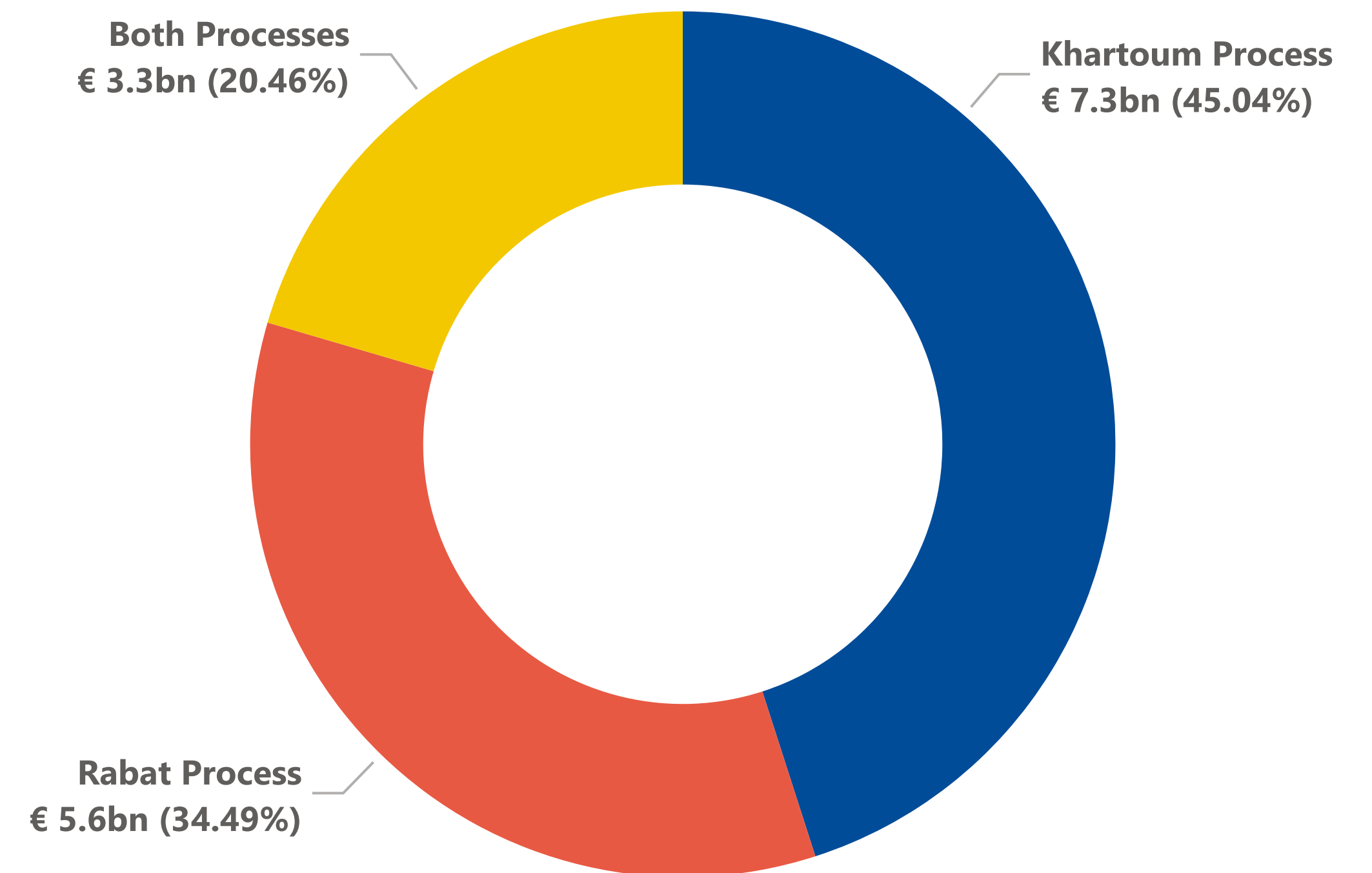


Overview By Regional Dialogues

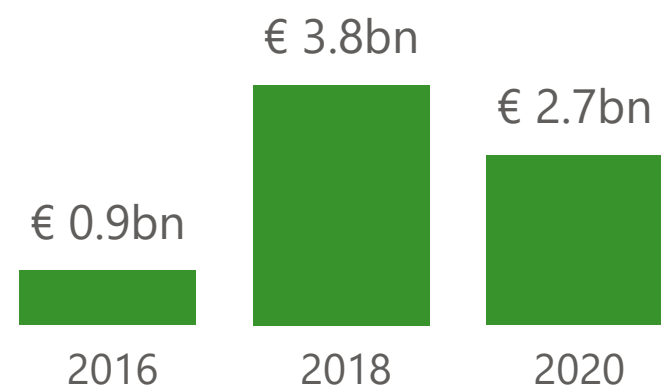


Domain 1: Development benefits of migration & root causes of irregular migration

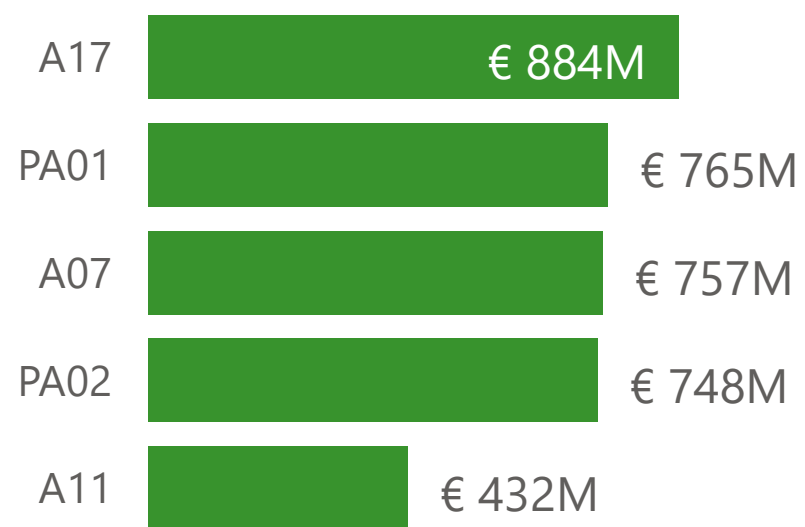

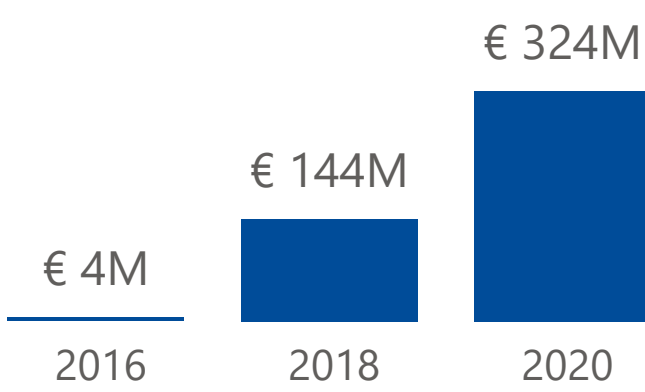


Domain 2: Legal migration and mobility

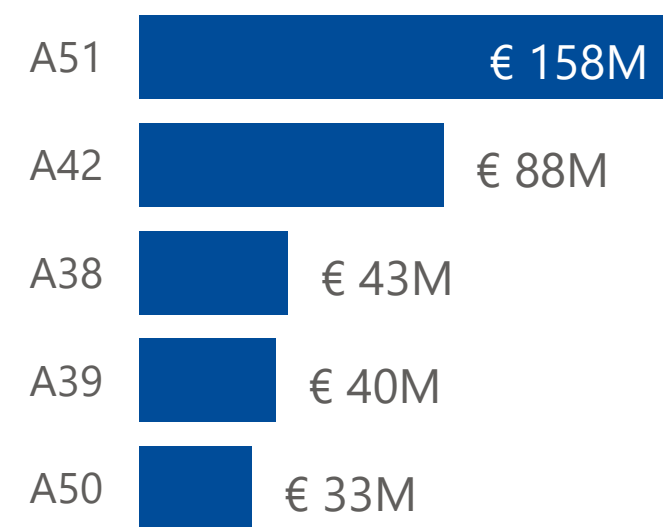

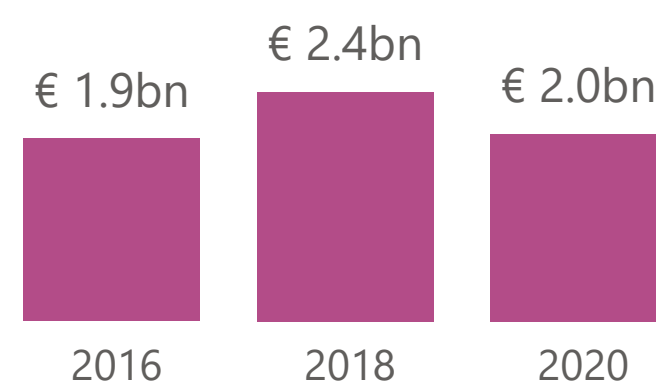

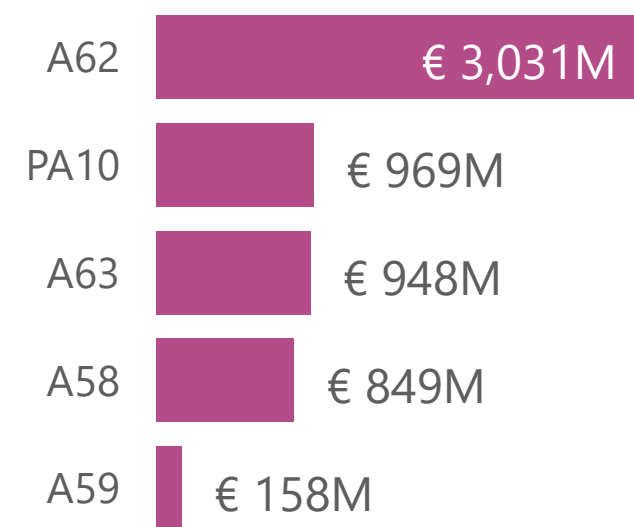

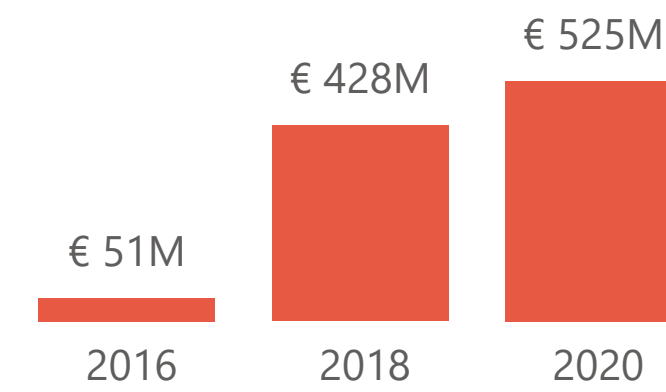


Domain 4: Prevention of and fight against irregular migration, migrant smuggling and trafficking in human beings

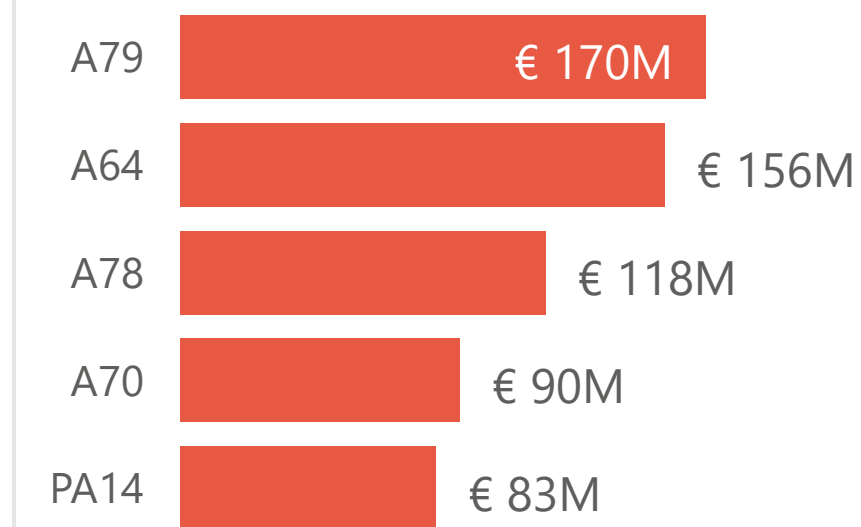

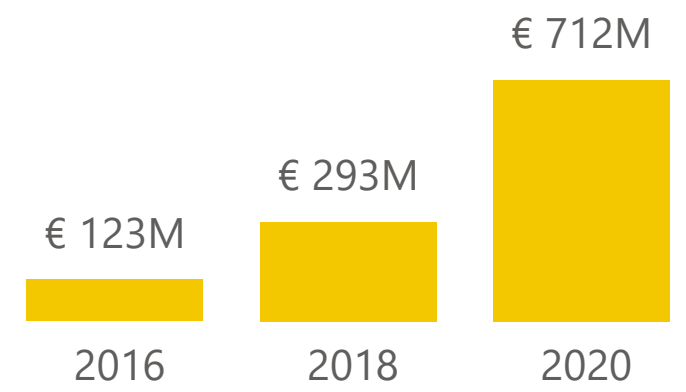


Domain 5: Return, readmission and reintegration

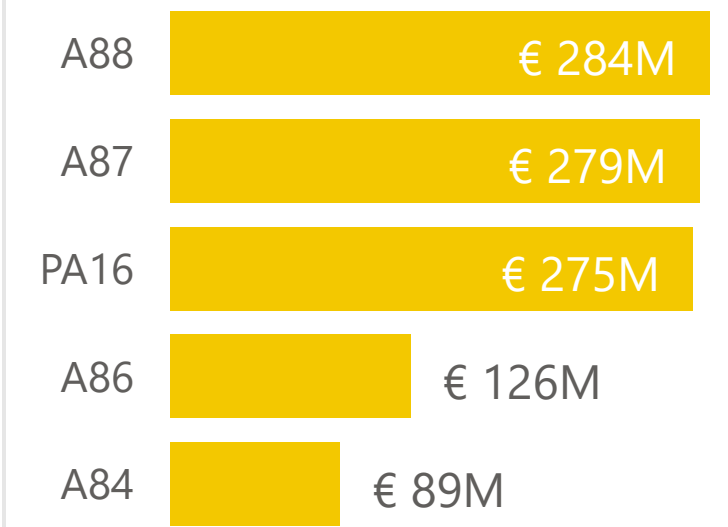

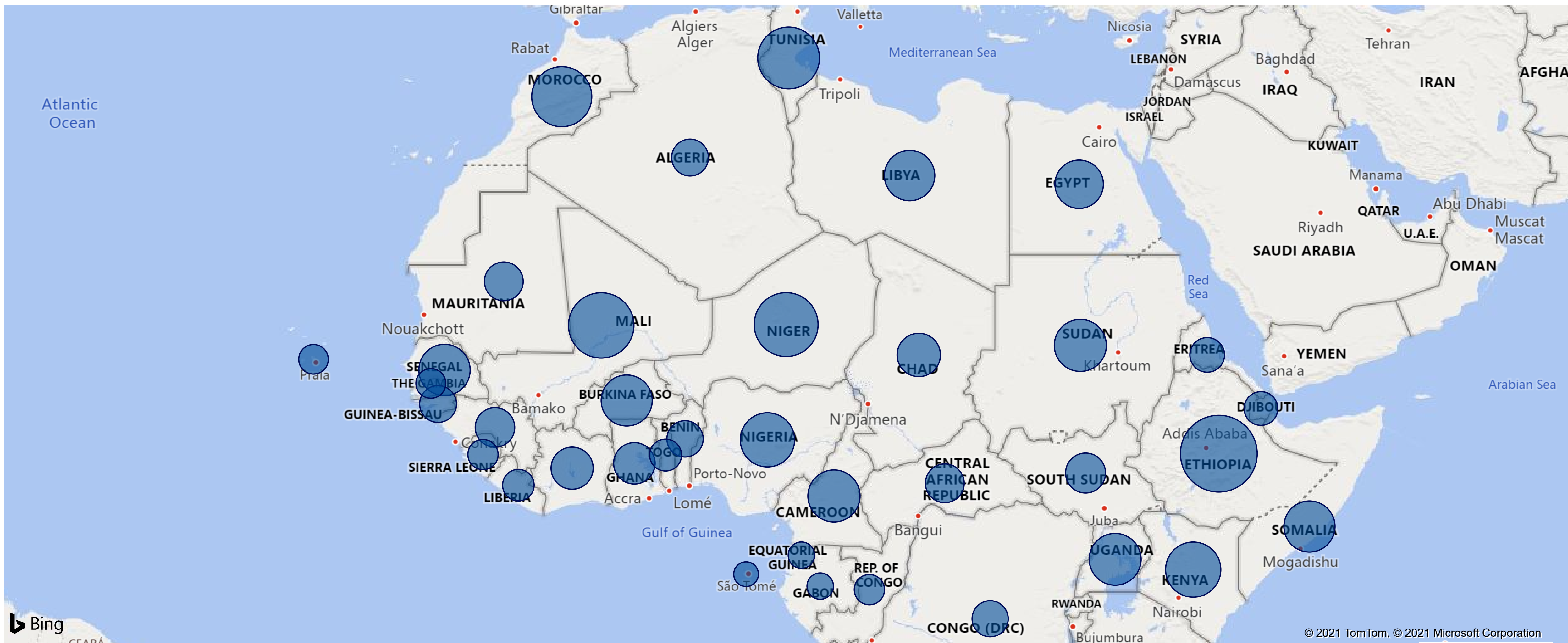

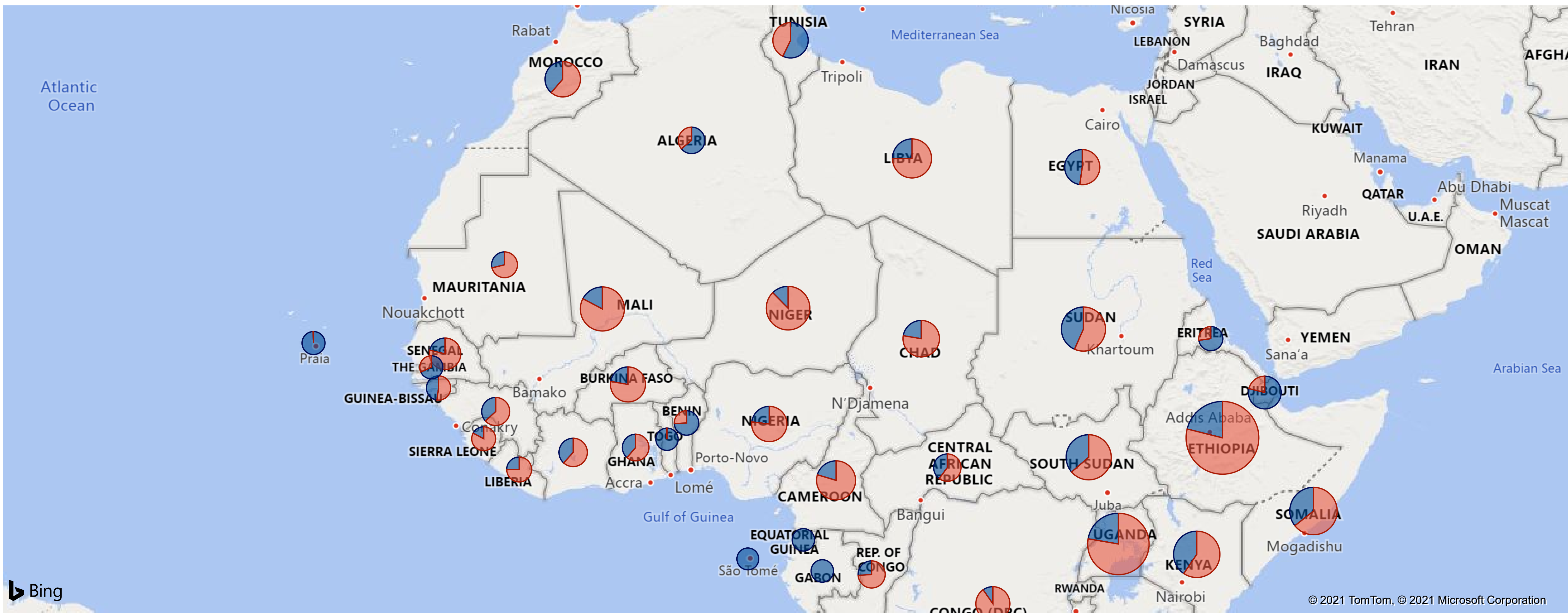

Distribution in Africa by N° of Initiatives

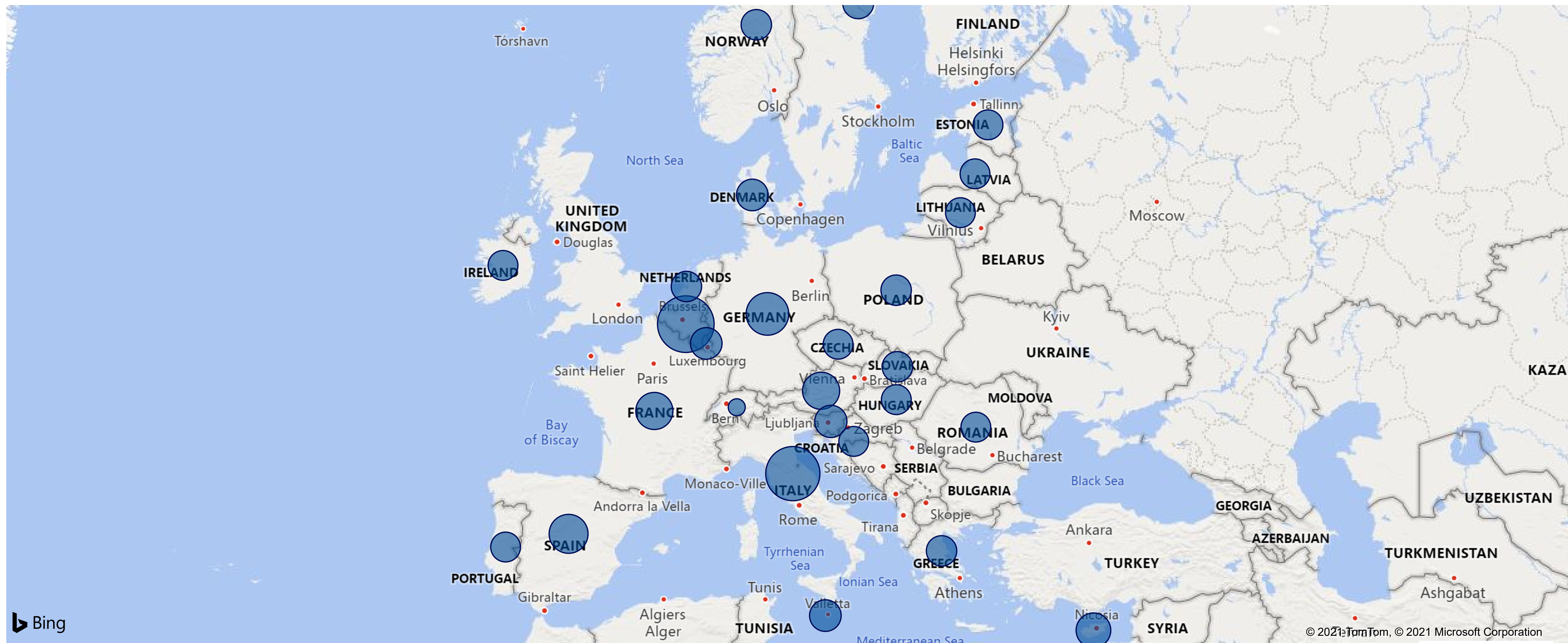


Distribution in Africa by funding

Distribution of Policies in Europe



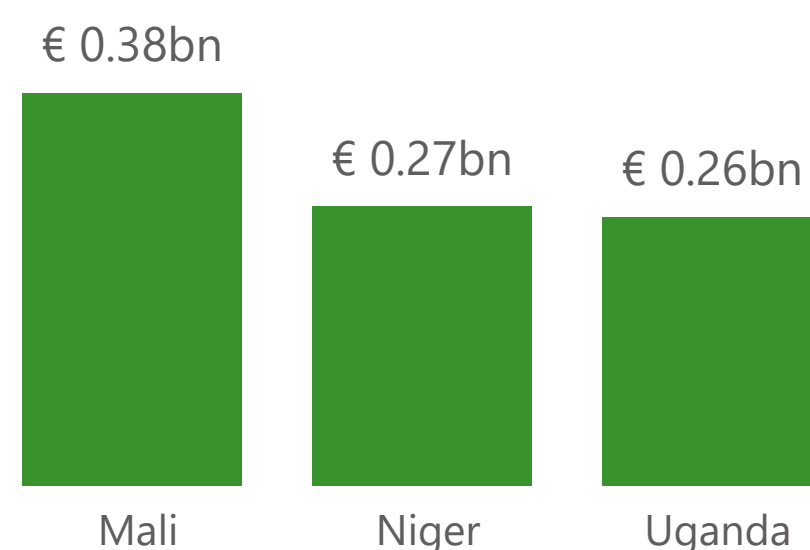

Funding per Top Countries



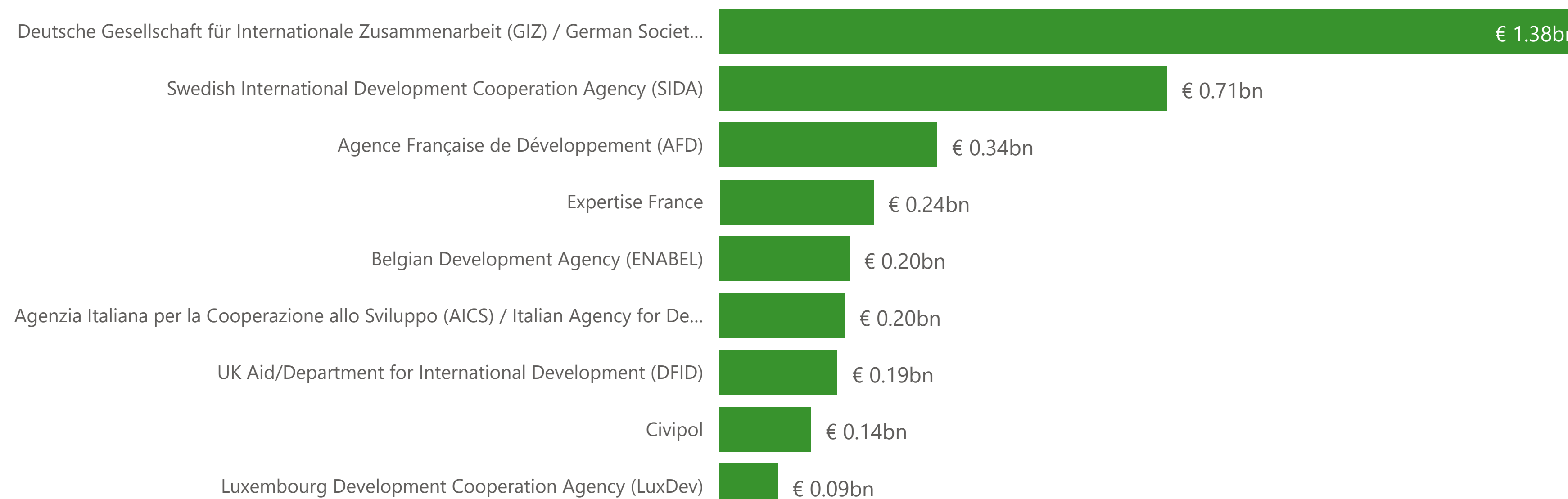
