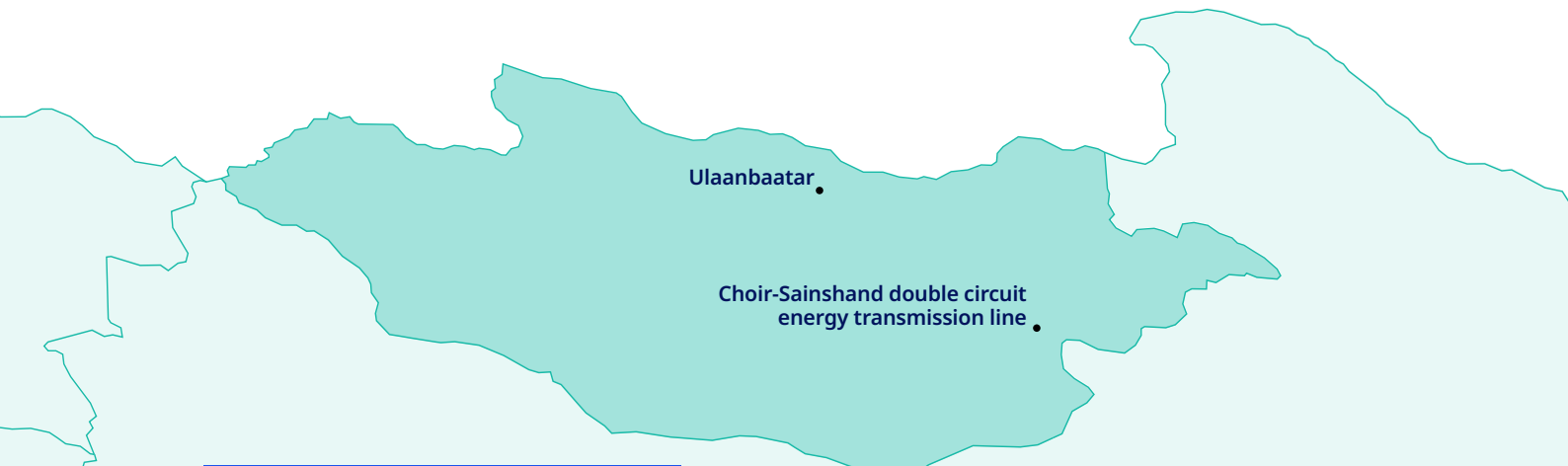


JUDICIAL REFORMS
 Improve the justice system's efficiency and credibility, ensuring an independent judiciary.

GREEN ECONOMIC GROWTH

Leverage financing on sustainable nature resource management, value chain development, and green energy:

- **Climate & Energy**
 Promote investments for green and climate resilience, and create a more enabling business environment on renewables:
 - Construction of the 220 km Choir-Sainshand double circuit energy transmission line
 - Construction, extension, and rehabilitation of water networks
 - Provision of basic infrastructure to secondary urban centres
 - Rehabilitation and installation of heating installations to help reduce pollution in Ulaanbaatar
 - Construction of a new sanitary landfill and waste recycling plant
- **Forest Partnership**
 Support Mongolia's goal to plant one billion trees by 2030 with a focus on sustainable management, forest conservation, and reduced deforestation



DIGITAL TRANSFORMATION
 Ensure the twin transition (green and digital) with focus on the regulatory framework, connectivity, and the promotion of e-governance, e-commerce, e-learning.

TRANSPARENCY IN PUBLIC FINANCES
 Contribute to fighting corruption across sectors, increase investors' and citizens' trust in national institutions and ensure more support for climate-sensitive policies.
