### HUMAN DEVELOPMENT

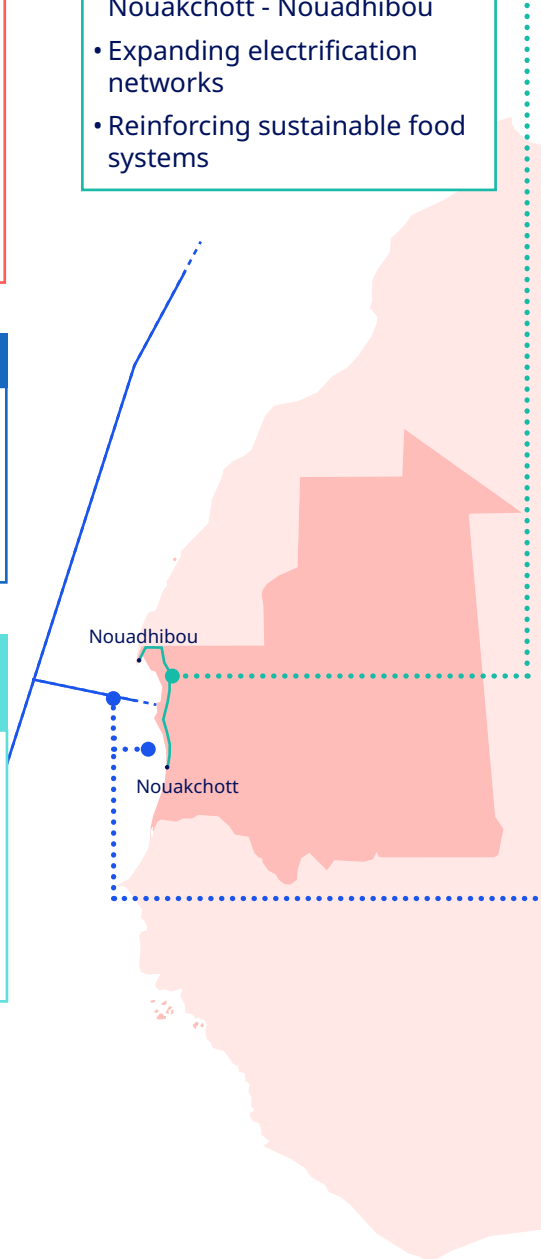
- Supporting the national education plan
