Addendum No. 1

to the multiannual indicative programme of the Thematic Programme for Civil Society Organisations for the period 2021-2027

Following the European Council Conclusions of 1 February 2024, requiring amongst others a EUR 2 billion redeployment within NDICI-Global Europe, the available financial envelope foreseen under the Thematic Programme for Civil Society Organisations for the period 2025-2027 is decreased by EUR 38.72 million.

The total budget for 2021-2027 is in turn reduced to EUR 1 473.13 million (including EUR 200 million from the NDICI-Global Europe cushion as per regulation).

The Thematic Programme for Civil Society Organisations has two main priorities: 1 - "An inclusive, participatory, empowered, and independent civil society and democratic space in partner countries; and an inclusive and open dialogue with and between civil society"; 2 - "A better-informed and more inclusive society with a developed sense of co-responsibility for sustainable development, including addressing global challenges (notably global inequalities and ecological crises) - [DEAR Programme]".

Recognising that CSO country financial support should remain stable and that the Policy Forum on Development (including the Global Gateway CSO-LAs platform) requires strengthening, funding for Priority 1 is slightly increased. The reduction of the allocation is therefore absorbed under Priority 2 and Support measures.

The multiannual indicative programme of the Thematic Programme for Civil Society Organisations for the period 2021-2027 is hereby amended as follows:

i. The amount of EUR 1 511.85 million referred to in the 4th paragraph of section 1 "Summary" is replaced by the following amount:

"EUR 1 473.13 million (including EUR 200 million from the NDICI-Global Europe cushion)."

ii. The amount of EUR 1 511.85 million referred to in the 1st paragraph of section 4 "Priorities selected for financing by the EU" is replaced by the following amount:

"EUR 1 473.13 million (including EUR 200 million from the NDICI-Global Europe cushion)."

iii. Under section 5 "Financial Overview", the table is fully replaced by the following table:

Addendum No. 1

to the multiannual indicative programme for the Thematic Programme "Global Challenges" for the period 2021-2027

Following the Mid-Term Review (MTR) of NDICI-Global Europe programming, no revision of the Thematic Programme "Global Challenges" was envisaged as the priority areas in the Multiannual Indicative Programme were still considered fully relevant. The MTR confirmed that the programme is essential to deliver on the EU's commitment to enhance global action tackling global challenges.

However, following the European Council Conclusions of 1 February 2024, requiring amongst others a EUR 2 billion redeployment within NDICI-Global Europe, the available financial envelope foreseen under the Thematic Programme for Global Challenges for the period 2025-2027 is decreased by EUR 82.5 million.

A pragmatic approach for the cuts based on a case-by-case analysis rather than a pro-rata approach by pillar was adopted given the importance of delivering on the significant pledges made under the People pillar.

The multiannual indicative programme for the Thematic Programme "Global Challenges" for the period 2021-2027 is hereby amended as follows:

to the multiannual indicative programme for the thematic programme on human rights and democracy for the period 2021-2027

The multiannual indicative programme (MIP) for the thematic programme on human rights and democracy for the period 2021-2027 is firmly rooted in the priorities of the EU Action Plan on Human Rights and Democracy 2020-2024. The EEAS and the Commission, in agreement with the Council, assessed that the current priorities are fit for purpose. The Council extended the duration of the Action Plan until 2027¹. In this context, the adjustments following the revision of the Multiannual Financial Framework (MFF) will inscribe themselves into ensuring continuity of the current objectives.

Adjustments, therefore, have been applied proportionally among regions/subregions and the various components of the MIP. This approach should allow to respect the original percentage targets identified in the MIP adopted in 2021.

The multiannual indicative programme for the thematic programme on human rights and democracy for the period 2021-2027 is hereby amended as follows:

i. The paragraphs and tables of section 5 "Financial overview" are replaced by the following paragraphs and tables:

"The financial envelope for the implementation of the programme on human rights and democracy is **EUR 1,473,151,800** for the period 2021-2027, of which EUR 200,000,000 from the NDICI-Global Europe cushion²."
