CLIMATE & ENERGY

Supporting agri-business, environment, and biodiversity protection:

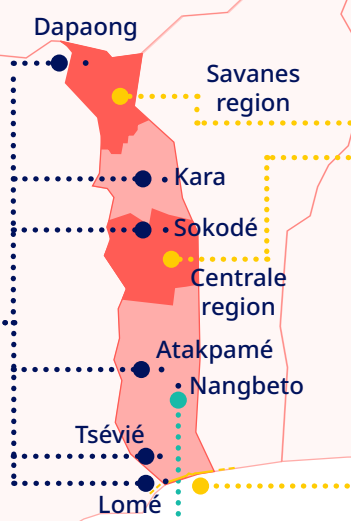
- Enhancing value chains for job creation, food security, local consumption and export opportunities
- Developing irrigation and rain-fed farming systems
- Promoting high nutritional food through providing seeds, developing school vegetable gardens and supporting women's agri-entrepreneurship
- Biodiversity regeneration and conservation, and agro-ecology

YOUNG BUSINESSES

Finance and technical assistance to young businesses.

GOVERNANCE

- Enhancing local waste management in the five main regional cities (Dapaong, Kara, Sokode, Atakpamé and Tsévié) and upgrading the Aképé landfill in Lomé
- Capacity-building and financing mechanisms for local authorities
- Strengthening institutions, partnership and dialogue through budget support



TRANSPORT

Rehabilitation of 31km of Lomé-Cotonou roads (Abidjan-Lagos transport corridor) and rural roads in the main agricultural areas.

CLIMATE & ENERGY

Achieving 100% electrification by 2030:

- Generating up to 4.5 MW of renewable energy
- Supporting the construction, rehabilitation and hybridisation of renewable energy power plants such as the Nangbeto Dam
- Extending and reinforcing the distribution network over 3500 km
- Improving the efficiency of electricity networks in 53 cities benefitting 500.000 people
- Strengthening energy governance and boosting private investment

SECURITY & RESILIENCE

- Increasing access to basic services such as electricity, drinking water, health care and waste systems in remote areas to reduce exposure to security threats
- Strengthening conflict management and supporting the Inter-ministerial Committee for the Fight against Violent Extremism (CIPLEV)
- Enhancing air and ground army capabilities and civil-military dialogue

These projects do not capture the entirety of the Team Europe engagement in the country. Infrastructure investments under Global Gateway will be accompanied by soft measures to improve the policy, regulatory and business environments, develop skills and foster innovation.
