- Ensure follow up of implementation of Global gateway flagships in the region.
- Track INTPA A3 performance of spending target

- Provide advice on subjects covered by the Directorate/Unit, including analysing thematic and/or country and regional issues, writing well-documented reports and briefing the hierarchy on matters pertaining to designated countries and region for cross-cutting issues.
