**TRANSPORT**

Investing in green urban mobility initiatives in Dakar, including the Bus Rapid Transit Project (electrical buses) and restructuring public transport with gas bus lines.

**ENERGY**

In collaboration with the Just Transition Energy Partnership, aiming for 40% renewable energy by 2030, with €2.5 billion backing from EU and global partners.

**DIGITAL**

Fostering a sustainable digital transition, emphasizing governance, entrepreneurship, and inclusivity targeting youth and women.

**SECURITY & STABILITY**

Addressing security threats in the southeast, enhancing border management, combating terrorism, and promoting peace in Casamance.

**MIGRATION**

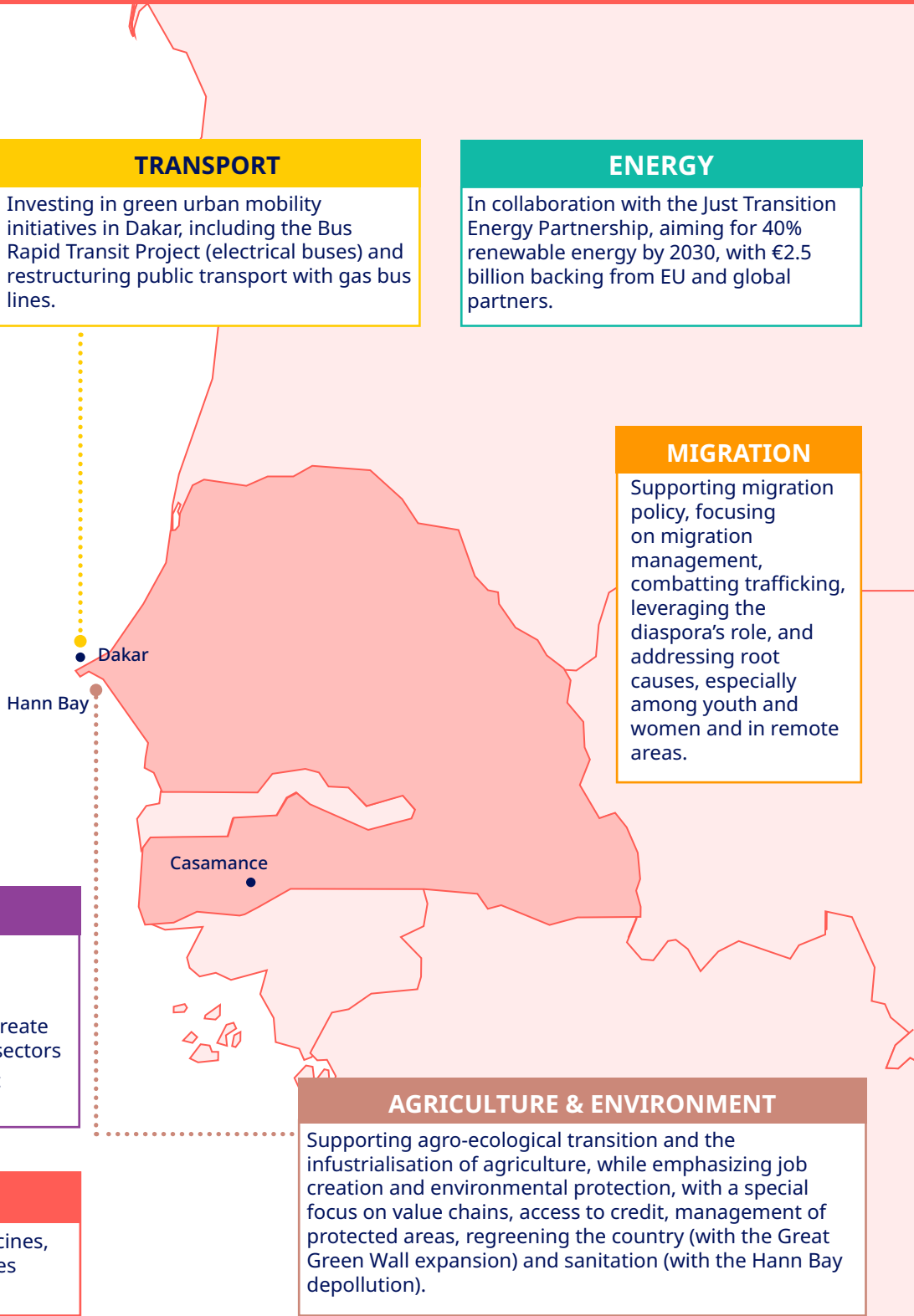
Supporting migration policy, focusing on migration management, combatting trafficking, leveraging the diaspora's role, and addressing root causes, especially among youth and women and in remote areas.

**YOUTH**

- Strengthen youth employability through technical and vocational education and training
- Promote entrepreneurship and create decent jobs in green and digital sectors
- Promote girls economic and civic empowerment

**PHARMACEUTICS**

Manufacturing and Access to Vaccines, Medicines and Health Technologies (MAV+).



**AGRICULTURE & ENVIRONMENT**

Supporting agro-ecological transition and the industrialisation of agriculture, while emphasizing job creation and environmental protection, with a special focus on value chains, access to credit, management of protected areas, greening the country (with the Great Green Wall expansion) and sanitation (with the Hann Bay depollution).

These outputs do not capture the whole of the Team Europe engagement in country. They capture concrete infrastructure investments under Global Gateway. They will be accompanied by soft measures in a 360° approach, so as to improve the policy, regulatory and business environment, develop skills, foster innovation and transfer technology.
