Governance, Peace & Security*

- Supporting structural reforms of the security services
- Promoting a favourable environment for civil society organisations
- Assisting in setting up transparent, participatory, and peaceful electoral processes
- Helping to mobilise better and more transparent domestic revenues, especially from the mining sector
- Fostering the improvement of the business climate and attractiveness for foreign investments

Human Development

- Improving access to better essential health services, including for mothers and children
- Strengthening women's rights and economic empowerment
- Increasing the number of pupils enrolled in school
- Supporting the improvement of the quality of teaching, including in technical education

Biodiversity & Agri-business

- Supporting the regeneration and conservation of biodiversity and agroecological systems in particular in
 NaturAfrica landscapes: Garamba, Salonga, Upemba, Virunga, and Yangambi
- Support selected value chains such as wheat, maize, cassava, and coffee/plantain banana to create jobs, increase food production and security, and expand export opportunities

Digital

- Supporting the development of digital infrastructure, including the deployment of a fibre optic cable in Eastern DRC and the construction of GSM antennas in remote areas
- Systematic support for digitalisation in a variety of sectors

Energy

Supporting renewable energy production and improving regional electricity distribution by:

- boosting private sector operations
- developing national and regional transmission lines, including the Ruzizi 3, DRC-Uganda, and DRC-Zambia lines
- · rehabilitating the Tshopo Hydropower Plant in Kisangani
- improving electricity supply from Virunga Park to Goma with the Rwanguba II Hydropower Plant
- supporting the development of a regional energy market and facilitating cross-border electricity exchanges

Sustainable Critical Raw Materials

- Development of sustainable raw materials value chains and mobilisation of funding for the infrastructure required
- Strengthening governance, due diligence and traceability, cooperation in the fight against illegal international trafficking and alignment with international ESG standards
- Boosting exploration, research and innovation, knowledge-sharing, and targeted technologies
- Enhancing capacity building, including strengthening trainings and skills development

Transport

- Development of the Lobito Corridor by renovating and modernizing the 420 km railway tracks from DRC to Angola
- Development of the multimodal section from Ubangi crossing to Zongo to the Lisala river port on the Congo River (part of the Douala-Kampala-Mombasa Corridor)
- Rehabilitation of roads, including Route Nationale 1
