YOUTH & EDUCATION

Support the strategy to diversify the economy towards high productivity knowledge-based sectors, necessitating a skilled labour force.

- **Education** through investment in education, technical and vocational skills, and early childhood development
- **Decent jobs** by enhancing the regulatory framework, improving the business climate in sectors like pharmaceuticals and mining, and fostering entrepreneurship

POLITICAL & ECONOMIC GOVERNANCE

Emphasize public accountability and citizen participation in decision-making processes.

- Support democratic participation, rule of law, human rights, and ending violence against women and girls
- Promote inclusive urbanisation with capital upgrades, urban mobility investment, and sustainable development of satellite cities

GREEN DEAL FOR INCLUSIVE DEVELOPMENT

Promote agricultural transformation towards social and environmentally inclusive food systems, emphasizing environmental, climate sustainability, and urbanisation.

- Support to food value chains and climate adaptation, and construction of Kigali Wholesale Market
- Promote inclusive urbanisation with capital upgrades, urban mobility investment, and sustainable development of satellite cities
