E-MOBILITY

Help transform the transport sector, the primary emissions source, for decarbonisation:

- Electrify approximately 1000 buses in the Greater Metropolitan Area over 5 years
- Support the development of a number of electric train projects such as the Electric Passenger Train of the Greater Metropolitan Area and the Limón Electric Freight Train (TELCA)



SUSTAINABLE FINANCE

Improve access to finance and develop the green bond market, thus mobilising capital for financing and sustainable transition.

DIGITAL TRANSFORMATION

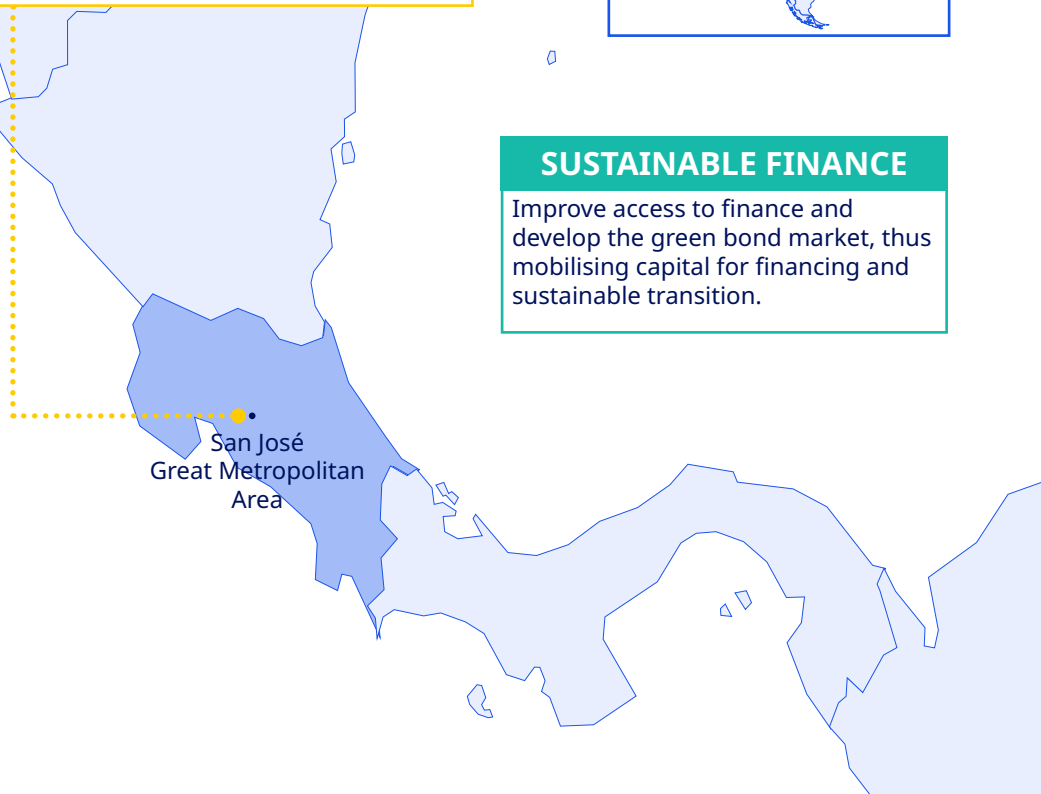
- Support Costa Rica's National Telecommunications Plan 2022-2027 for secure digital connectivity
- Help finance 5G roll-out, securing networks and critical infrastructure, including through enhanced cyber competences

HEALTH

Support the development, testing and production of medicines and medical devices, while fostering human talent, legal frameworks and digital tools for better services.

SUSTAINABLE AGRICULTURE & FISHING

Boost bio-inputs, organic certification and production, low carbon value chains, and circular practices in agriculture and fisheries to enhance EU-Costa Rica trade and support the EU-Central America Association Agreement.
